Dear Mr. Anderson:

This firm is counsel to Abington Township and the Abington Township Municipal Authority on whose behalf this letter is written.

On Tuesday, May 2, 1995 it was observed that the waste water entering the treatment facilities was noticeably discolored and a sample of that waste water was collected as was a sample from the manhole and elbow pipe directly outside your facility. Those samples were analyzed and revealed the presence of chromium in the treatment plant sample of 9.24 mg/L (sample 834) and 63.2 mg/L in the sample emanating from Precision. These results exceed the federal categorical pretreatment standard daily chromium discharge limit for the metal finishing industry of 2.77 mg/L by more than 3 and nearly 23 times, respectively.

In addition, this discharge of industrial waste into the municipal sewer system constitutes a violation of the "Agreement For Connection of Private Sewer Extension" dated November 5, 1979 between Precision and the Authority which "... shall be cause for immediate termination of service." See paragraph 2.


You are hereby ordered to appear at the Township Municipal Building at 7:30 p.m. on Thursday, May 11, 1995 to discuss this situation in detail. You are to bring to this meeting all documentation of discharges of chromium and or industrial waste from Precision National Plating Services into the municipal sewer system within the last six months and records of all tests or analysis performed on waste water being discharged to the municipal

Failure to attend this meeting will result in the Township and Municipal Authority availing themselves of any and all remedies provided in the Agreement or at law, including but not limited to the termination of sewer service to your facility.
